On the last day of Tana Bana a minimela was organised with the help of kids of Udaan Learning centre. Handmade products, crotchet material, best out of waste products like purses and ear-rings were highlights of the exhibition. Kids and adults put up stalls Cake, Momos, Puchka etc.

"Nobody wants to wear local wool now. Delhiites want soft and fancy wool even if the yarns break after the first wash," said **Mansaram Ji**, Tana Bana participant and a local Kandhbari weaver who lost interest in weaving some 15 years ago and now only weaves to earn a minimum livelihood.

His two sons have also migrated to other professions such as government service and the Indian Army. "Children in other families, too, are running after education, job and mobile phones," he added.
